28 April 2019	The work 'Wivenhoe' was screened at the 'Imagined Faraway Lands' screening at Caraboo project Bristol.
July 2019- August 2020	Develop and finish works 'Landscape with Satyr and Nymphs Dancing', 'Somerset Flood', 'The English Garden' The works incorporated the research method and contextual research that had been developed during the earlier phases and then the changes that had occured after both the public screening events and the Elastic Spaces symposium and focused the thematic approach within the post pastoral (Gifford) mode.
October 2020	Exhibition 'Post Pastoral' at Centrespace Bristol. The exhibition showed all 5 works and was the culmination of this stage of the project.

November 2020Publish Article 'Landscape Composite' in the International Journal of
Creative Media Research. The article maps the development of the whole
project and critically reflects on the development of the works, the
methodm, the dissemination of the project and the key findings.
