May 2012	Stage 1: Greenland Research Trip This project was conceived in conversation with Mariele Neudecker and Gretel Ehrlich and a plan was made to join them on a research trip to Greenland. We were looking for a remote nature, beyond landscape, beyond the grid.

Sep 2015	Stage 3: Experiments in Paint
	Began series of experiments with Bath Spa University's Paint Technician Tim Davies exploring how to create an avalanche using paint. (e.g. using layers of slow drying paint under more stable fast drying ones and using gravity as the force to begin process.
April 2016	Explored a series of experiments using the force from a shot gun to start avalanches in paint, working with a member of local gun group.
June 2016	Began a series of experiments with the Explosives technician at the Academy of Defence in Shrivenham. Creating avalanches and crevasses in paint using the force of explosions.
