EXPRESSION OF INTEREST / UGO PROJECT SPACE / BRITISH ART SHOW 8 / SOUTHAMPTON ASSOCIATE PROGRAMME

> PROPOSAL: WHAT IS UGO PROJECT SPACE?

UGO Project Space is a rolling programme of large format public artworks, which utilizes an underused billboard to present a series of individual, critical contemporary work by Southampton-based and nationally renowned artists. The project would present an interesting format for the artists to consider the purpose, context and outcome, generating new pieces specifically for the framework, but very much embedded in their ongoing practice.

It is the aim of the project to use the public reach of the 'overt' advertising format to provide as many individuals as possible the opportunity to access, question and experience contemporary art practice. Whilst also being a prominent example of the city increasing engagement with and support of creative art initiatives that hope to replicate the qualities and direction associated with the British Art Show, as a showcase for emerging, exciting and engaging current practices which also presents a convergence of physical and virtual practices.

The artists selected have been specifically approached via a number of evolving criteria. UGO is not only an opportunity to visually contribute to develop a further platform for a greater visual art scene in the city, but also an opportunity for important local artists to actually present their work in Southampton. The programmes curatorial intentions have developed to present a variety of practices, from local and national artists who will raise the profile of UGO, links to BAS or/and who's practice sits well within the city context and artists with local concerns.

The project has approached a number of artists and I have been really delighted and genuinely surprised that all have wanted to create a work for *UGO*. The proposal intends to present 6 artists initially [see: DURATION] as part of the Associate Programme, but has the opportunity to develop as ongoing platform for contemporary artistic practice in the city.

> VENUE / LOCATION

The proposed venue is a newly renovated '16 sheet' billboard 2 meters x 3 meters, located on the junction of the A3035 [St Deny's Road] & Priory Road, approximate coordinates 50.924561-1.381155. The billboard faces the oncoming traffic from Bitterne Park as the audience cross Cobden Bridge and continue onto St Denys, Portswood and Highfield. The billboard's location allows for a significant number of individuals to view *UGO*.

> DURATION

As part of the Associate Programme *UGO* would have the opportunity to run across the whole of the British Art Show 8 in Southampton and 24 hours a day. The proposal has selected a 6-month duration, because it allows for a number of important factors. Firstly, the presentation of the first work a month before BAS8, helps to increase awareness of the project space, the locality, agenda and reputation, building a knowledgeable local audience. Secondly, it allows for a greater diversity and opportunity to present works from the local and nationally renowned artists already interested in the project. This larger timeframe for example allows for the possible incorporation of *UGO* into the multi-site-specific [US/UK] public artworks as part of artist S Mark Gubb's solo show at SYSON, Nottingham in October-December 2016. Finally, the duration provides the greatest opportunity for a legacy of the Associate Programme, not only in the 6 month duration, but this also demonstrates the rigor, impact and success of *UGO*. The documentation of which will help support a stronger chance of *UGO* being successful at gaining further funding [crowd-funded & art grants] and platforms in which the project space could develop i.e. securing the site for longer, finding new or multi-site[s], commissioning designs. Generating an established new platform for critical contemporary artistic practice in Southampton.
