#### The project

Design Manchester is inviting designers and image-makers to submit a personal response to words written by Mark E Smith.

The submissions will be presented at Bury Art Museum and Sculpture Centre. Mark E Smith lived in Prestwich near, Bury for most of his life, so it is fitting that the work is exhibited in Bury Art Museum.

This is a visual celebration of, independence, individuality and language disruption!.

## What we want you to do.

Choose your favourite ONE line from a MES lyric.

You can illustrate the words in any way you like, 2d/3d. You could create a photographic, drawn or digital response.

How you create your image is up to you.

Your submission will form a set of collected responses to words written by MES. Cut up sentences re arranged to form a new MES visual/ typographic syntax.

There will be an event at the Gallery on October 12th for the exhibition to coincide with the launch of Design Manchester 18. Invitations to this event will be sent nearer the time.



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#### **Format**

- Please supply ONE single image
- must be A3 sized artwork (landscape or portrait)
- No restriction on colour, can be full, 2 colour or Black+White.
- Please supply images at least 300dpi.
- All fonts and images must be embedded in a single image, please do not send your original Creative Suite files with links.
- PDF/JPEG/TIFF format are fine.
- Please include the following in your submission
  The line of lyric you have chosen to visualise, plus the song/album it comes from (this is helpful as there is a lot of work out there)

- Designers must grant basic rights to display submissions as part of the wider exhibition, and to display alongside other festival events
